Town Attorney Kenyon updated the Board in regards to the Clement's store. The proposed buyer submitted an application to the Town of Richmond Planning Board to store the soil and aerate it from the site. His request was denied by the Richmond Planning Board. We will be waiting to see what his next step will be.

Town Attorney Kenyon updated the Board on the Article 78 proceeding with John Fox. The Court ruled that the ZBA incorrectly interpreted the law. Carports are not regulated in our zoning. The owner should apply for an area variance.

There was an error made in emailing the March minutes to all the Town Board members. They will be resent and action taken next month.

Robert Stryker, Chairman of the Planning Board submitted his monthly report. They had two informational requests for subdivision information on Rt 64 and County Road 33. They have started review on the minor subdivision regulations. A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to accept his report.

Pete Wojtas, Code Enforcement Officer, submitted his monthly report. He and Phil Sommer attended the FLBOA conference and received their annual 24 hour training. He has sent out letter notifying owners of permits that are nearing expiration. The ZBA has approved a Special Use Permit granting Ernest DiBella a pole barn off the Town ROW on Rt 64. They also granted Alan Jones an area variance for a barn setback on Case Road. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept his report.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by David Parsons and carried to hold a Public Hearing on May 9, 2011 at 7:00 PM to consider adopting a Local Law on Site Plan and a Local Law on the proposed Zoning Ordinance.

Tom Stevens reported that everything seems to be going well for Fun Day. We had to get another band, Baker, Paulsen and Garvey overbooked and will not be able to play. Tom has contacted Double Take to perform. The next meeting will be May 4th.

Steve Kepner, Highway Supt. submitted his monthly report. Discussion was held on the Highway Department helping a contractor. The intent was to receive spoil material for use by the town. Councilperson Stevens will investigate. A copy of his report is on file with the Town Clerk. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept his report.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report for March. A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by David Parsons and carried to accept her report.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to appoint Jennifer Sanford to the ZBA to fill the vacancy of EJ Warden. Her term to begin immediately and expires on December 31/2013.

The Supervisor advised the Board that Pratt Disposal has agreed to have the transfer station open on Wednesday evenings from 4:00-7:00 PM on April 27, May 11 & 25, and June 8 & 22.

The Supervisor advised the Board that he will begin to get bids for chipping the brush at the transfer station.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:55 PM.
