William Kenyon, Town Attorney, reported that there was nothing new to report on the Clement's Store. Supervisor Green inquired about the possibility of having the area mowed. Bill will check with the potential buyer to see if he has any plans to have the area mowed. If he doesn't, Bob will have someone do it and charge it back to the buyer.

Peter Wojtas, Code Enforcement Officer, reported that the Planning Board did not have a meeting, because they were attending a training seminar in Geneva.

Peter Wojtas, Code Enforcement Officer, submitted his monthly report. Six permits were issued in May. He attended the county CEO's meeting where they discussed hording concerns in the county and the new electrical code. They did safety inspections at Davis, Naracong and Boylan's salvage yards. Tom Stevens gave a report on Fun Day. Revenues taken in from the silent auction, popcorn sales, photo booth and raffle were \$1,037.19.

Steve Kepner, Highway Supt., submitted his monthly report. He reported that the new 1500 gallon collection tank for the shop floor drain has been installed. A motion was made by Supervisor Green and seconded by David Parsons and carried to declare the light bulbs from the shop as surplus and take them to the transfer station and place a sign on them free to the first come first serve. A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Al Favro and carried to have the Supervisor sign the state snow and ice agreement-amendment B for an adjustment of \$22,420.72. A copy of his report is on file with the Town Clerk. A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept his report.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept her report.

The Supervisor advised the Board that he would be requesting quotes for the chipping of the brush at the transfer site. It was suggested that he barter to have some chips double ground for the playground area.

The Supervisor brought it to the attention of the Board that he was approached by the Boy Scouts to pass out flyers at the transfer site for a can drive. It was the concern of the Board on the safety of the participants. Bob will check with our insurance carrier for any issues that they may have
