Privilege of the floor was given to James Gresens from MRB Group. He gave a project summary of the highway garage dry well. MRB solicited quotes from 3 environmental contractors to perform GeoProbe drilling activities to determine if contamination is present within the dry well. TREC Environmental was the lowest quote. TREC Environmental drilled holes using the GeoProbe equipment. MRB Group submitted a report of the site investigation, the lab results and a finding summary to the NYSDEC. There was no petroleum impacts to the soil. There was still impact from metals that warrant excavation and disposal of some soil. MRB Group provided an opinion of probable costs to the Board for several scenarios to remediate the dry well. A motion was made by AL Favro and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to have TREC Environmental excavate the material and haul it to an approved site since they have the required procedures and licenses to haul this type of waste. The town will use their own town resources to place the necessary holding tank.

Privilege of the floor was given to Pete Wojtas. He asked the Board if they would consider having the transfer site open one evening during the week. The Supervisor said he would contact Pratt Disposal to see if they would consider the suggestion.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept the February 14, 2011 minutes as presented.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to pay the following bills:

The Supervisor advised the Board that he was notified by the NYS Thruway that a CHIPS check from 2009 was not cashed. After reviewing the matter with the bookkeeper, he notified them that apparently the check was never received by the town and to further investigate the possibility of reissuing another check.

Robert Stryker, Chairman of the Planning Board submitted his monthly report. The Board has finalized their comments on the zoning changes. The Town Board

members will be sent their copy by email by the secretary. Bob asked if it would be possible to have the zoning code, once adopted, placed on the web site. The Board felt it would be a good idea and would pursue the suggestion. Bob asked if the Town Board would like to have the Planning Board start reviewing the minor subdivision regulations. A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Al Favro and carried to let the Planning Board begin their review and updating of the minor subdivision regulations. A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by David Parsons and carried to accept his report.

Peter Wojtas, Code Enforcement Officer, submitted his monthly report. A copy of his report is on file with the Town Clerk. He and Phil Sommer attended a Hoarding Awareness seminar at the Ontario County Safety Building. Phil signed up to be a member of a task force committee which was formed to further study this subject. A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept his report.

Steve Kepner, Highway Supt. submitted his monthly report which is on file with the Town Clerk. He revised the values of the equipment which helped reduce the insurance premium. He discussed the cell phone usage with his employees. He and other Highway Superintendent from the County went to Albany to meet with our State Legislators. A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept his report.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report. A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept her report.

Discussion was held on changing the time of the Town Board meeting to 6:30 PM. It was decided not to change the time and keep it at 7:00 PM.

The Supervisor reported that Integrated Systems has updated the firewall and virus protection for our computers.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:30 PM.
