essary to have the terms of the ZBA members staggered still in the ordinance since they are a five year term. The Town Attorney advised the Board that it made no difference if it was in there or not. The Board decided to leave it as is. Councilman Stevens suggested that Article Six-Section IV be discussed. After some discussion a motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to remove the sentence “no accessory use building shall be erected prior to construction of a principle use building.” and also to change the word “residential” to principle. A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to adopt Local Law #3- Zoning Local Law as amended. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Tom Stevens to close the Public Hearing.

The Supervisor called the regular meeting to order at 7:40 PM. There was no one present to address privilege of the floor.

A correction was made to the March minutes to rescind the budget modification motion and wait until the April meeting to make the budget modification to allow the Board members to consider the transfer of funds. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Tom Stevens to accept the March minutes as corrected and the April minutes as presented.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by David Parsons and carried to pay the following bills:

Steve Kepner, Highway Supt. submitted his monthly report. A copy of his report is on file with the Town Clerk. There were severe washouts on Kear, Dugway and South Hill roads from the last rain storm. He attended training on inoculation for Emerald Ash Borer. He helped Al Favro pressure wash the inside of the park pavilion in preparation of the beginning of the summer rental season. A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept his report.

Bulk water sales for April was \$230.00.

The Town Attorney updated the Board on the Clement store progress. There appears to be too much moisture in the soil at this time to transfer it to an approved landfill site. Our attorney has had a discussion with the attorney for Hartford Insurance on reimbursement for out of the pocket costs. They feel that their client should not be responsible for the reimbursement. They will continue their discussion.

Bob Stryker, Planning Board Chairman, submitted his monthly report. They are continuing their work on the minor subdivision regulations. They will be creating a form for the combination of lots. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept his report.

Pete Wojtas, Code Enforcement Officer, submitted his monthly report. A copy of his report is on file with the Town Clerk.

Fun Day Committee report was given by Tom Stevens. They had a meeting last week. A group will do a presentation on colonial war re-enactment that day. Next meeting will be June 8<sup>th</sup>.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report. A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept her report.

A copy of the sales tax revenue comparison was given to the Board members. Sales tax was up \$4,210.00 this quarter from the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter in 2010.

Joe Stoltz, Fire Chief, gave the Board members a handout of the how an ambulance call would be handled with an EMT available or if an EMT is not available or how it would be handled with a first responder from the fire department. He will keep the Board updated on status of EMS with the fire department.

The Supervisor notified the Board that Town Historian, Helen Fax has been nominated for the Senior Volunteer of the Year by the Ontario County Office for the Aging. The ceremony will be held at Vienna Gardens in Phelps on May 20 at 1:30 PM.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 PM.
