NOVEMBER 14, 2011

The privilege of the floor was given to Peter Jones. He presented pictures of conditions on some town roads. He feels that the highway superintendent is being negligent in his responsibilities and that the Town Board should be more accountable to the residents. Councilman Stevens explained to Mr. Jones that if he had issues with the Highway Superintendent, he should make an appointment to sit down and express his concerns there. The Town Board meeting was not the place for this discussion. Residents from Lower Egypt Road were present and continued to express their concerns on the use of the gravel pit owned by Mr. Fields.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept the minutes of the October 4<sup>th</sup> meeting with one typo correction, and the minutes of both the October 12<sup>th</sup> and 17<sup>th</sup> meeting as presented.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by David Parsons and carried to pay the following bills:

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept the Supervisor's financial report for October.

Discussion was held on the amount due for the NYS Retirement invoice due next month. The Supervisor advised the Board members that a transfer of funds will be required as the amount budgeted was not sufficient.

Revenue taken in at the bulk water station was \$150.00.

Town Attorney advised the Board that the Clement store transfer should close next week and the Town should have their settlement within a few days.

Robert Stryker, Chairman of the Planning Boars submitted his report. He has received agricultural district maps and placed them in the zoning office. At their meeting they discussed chairman of 2012. They will submit the name of Nate Harvey for chairman and suggest the Joann Rogers be reappointed as a member.

Pete Wojtas, Code Enforcement Officer, submitted his monthly report. A copy is on file with the Town Clerk.

Steve Kepner, Highway Superintendent, submitted his monthly report. A copy of his report is on file with the Town Clerk. A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by David Parsons and carried to buy a new air compressor and declare the old one as surplus and scrap. A new employee was hired to fill the position left vacant by Aaron Pestle. His name is Mike Kraft of Evert Road. Fog lines have been placed on Egypt Road and County Road 33.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept the monthly reports given by all departments.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by Tom Stevens to approve the 2012 fire contract with the removal of \$1500 for snow plowing, and consider holding the additional radio requested monies equaling \$20,000 per year, in a Town reserve fund for the Fire Department. Discussion followed as to whether to start the radio with-holding this year or next. The motion was made to take place next year when the topic will be re-visited. Vote: yes=4 (Favro, Green, Parsons, Stevens) no=1 (Harter).

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by David Parsons and carried to adopt the 2012 Preliminary Budget, as amended, for the 2012 Town Budget.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Supervisor Green and carried to Pass to Tax Resolution for unpaid water charges for the Bristol-Canandaigua Water District for \$2,082.18 and transmit such statement to the Ontario County Board of Supervisor's to levy such sums against property liable.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Al Favro and carried to withdraw the Pass To Tax Resolution made at the October 5, 2011 town board meeting, in regards to the levy of costs for the property at 4503 Rt 64.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to hold a Public Hearing on December 12, at 7:00 PM to consider Local Law #6-Regulations for Minor Subdivisions and Land Development.

The Organizational Meeting will be held on January 3, 2012.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to re-appoint JoAnn Rogers to the Planning Board. Her term to expire 12/31/16.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by David Parsons and carried to re-appoint Martin Snyder to the Zoning Board of Appeals. His term to expire 12/31/16.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Al Favro and carried to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 PM.
