MAY 13, 2013

William Kenyon, Atty                Lynn Cronise asked if it was the same as the previous  
   Local Law adopted June 11, 2012. She was told it was and  
that this would extend it for another 18 months to allow the town to further study and  
review and update our zoning laws to address the concerns of heavy industry. Lawrence  
Karz asked if the information provided by Boylan Code would be available for the public  
for their review. The Supervisor said it would be after the Board had a chance to study it.  
Nick Cohen asked if a committee has been appointed to review the Comprehensive Plan.  
He was told that the Planning Board is handling the matter. The Public Hearing was  
closed at 7:10 PM.

The regular meeting was called to order. There was no one present who wished  
privilege of the floor.

A correction was made to the April minutes that the percent of increase to the  
CHIPS allotment would be approximately 28%. A motion was made by Tom Stevens  
and seconded by Al Favro and carried to accept the minutes as corrected.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by Al Favro and carried to pay  
the following bills:

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Al Favro and carried to  
accept the Supervisor's financial report for April.

Bulk water sales for April were \$170.00.

Nate Harvey, Chairman of the Planning Board submitted his monthly report. A  
copy is on file with the Town Clerk. On June 8<sup>th</sup> he will be attending a workshop with  
Boylan Code.

Sandy Riker, Secretary for the ZBA gave the report for the Code Enforcement  
office. Six permits were issued. Several letters were sent out for Court appearances and  
property maintenance issues. Sandy attended the NYS Planning Federation conference in  
Saratoga Springs.

Tom Stevens reported that donations are being received for Fun Day. Vendors  
have been requesting spaces to set up booths. Next meeting is May 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Ron Wilson, Hwy Supt submitted his monthly report. They are in the process of  
moto paving Vincent Hill Road. Truck 9 was sent to the Palmyra auction and was sold  
for \$23,500.00. After further inspection of the excavator that Canandaigua was selling, it  
was decided not to purchase it. Over the next weeks the grading of dirt roads will be  
done and dust control will be put down.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept all departmental reports.

Discussion was held on the culvert/private property issue at Whitetail Hills. It was decided that the Highway Supt., David Parsons, Tom Stevens and Geoffrey Brennesel will schedule a meeting to look at the situation. The Town Attorney asked if he could take a look at Mr. Brennesel's abstract to see if an easement was established.

The Town Attorney explained to the Board members on the procedure of how to convene as a Board of Health and what they are responsible for.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by David Parsons and carried to authorize NYS Electrical Inspection Agency as an approved agency to perform electrical inspections within the Town of Bristol, with the stipulation that the Town is named as additional insured on the certificates of insurance.

Sandy Riker spoke to the Board on the possibility of allowing a farmers market at the Levi Corser Park. She has spoke with Jamalia Hessler of Cornell Cooperative Extension and will be receiving information for starting one.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to adopt Local Law #1- Tax Cap Override. Roll call vote: Aden Favro – Yes, Bruce Harter – Yes, David Parsons – Yes, Thomas Stevens – Yes and Robert Green – Yes.

A motion was made by Alden Favro and seconded by Thomas Stevens and carried to adopt Local Law #2 – To establish, impose and extend an existing moratorium within the Town of Bristol of Natural Gas and Petroleum exploration and extraction activities, underground storage of natural gas, and disposal o natural gas or petroleum extraction, exploration and production wastes. Roll cal vote; Alden Favro – Yes, Bruce Harter – Yes, David Parsons – Yes, Thomas Stevens – Yes, Robert Green – Yes.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by David Parsons and carried to adopt the Standard Workday and Reporting Resolutions for 2012 and 2013. Copies attached to these minutes.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by David Parsons and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:25 PM.
