## **Bristol Town Court**

Oops, I got a ticket.....now what?

- Plead Guilty Fill out Section A of the ticket you were issued by the officer. Make sure your address is correct. Return by date on the left side of the ticket, about two thirds of the way down on the page. The judge will assess a fine and you will be mailed a Fine Notice. Instructions on how to pay will be on this notice.
- Plead Not Guilty Fill out Section B of the ticket you were issued by the officer. Make sure your address is correct. Return by date on the left side of the ticket, about two thirds of the way down on the page. You may correspond with the Assistant District Attorney (Jeremiah.King@co.ontario.ny.us) regarding a possible reduced charge and further instructions on how to proceed. The court will adjourn your case until a resolution is reached.

<u>Small Claims:</u> - Most questions can be answered by visiting <u>www.NYCourt Help.gov</u>. If you do not have access to a computer, contact the Court by phone (585-229-4523) or in person and ask them for a Small Claims Booklet. Bristol Town Court has office hours on **Wednesdays from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.** If the defendant lives, works, or has a place of business in the Town, you can use the Small Claims Court. There is a maximum of \$3,000 on any claim brought into Small Claims Court in the Town.
