➤ Confirm correct numbers in "Housing" section – 25 or 28?

➤ Add graphic back in for Tax section.

➤ Section 4 Future Land Use will be changed to Policy, Objectives, & Action Items – B&L will revert to previous revisions from committee and pick up on those identified during this meeting.

➤ Potential Partners will be more generalized so we don't risk missing organizations. Dr. Bruce Gilman will be added to the acknowledgements section and retained where specific quotes are, otherwise it will be changed to FLCC.'
