Joint meeting of Town Board, Planning & ZBA Boards

Meeting started at 6:00 pm as posted on the Town Webpage. The purpose of starting the meeting at that time so the three Boards and others present could listen to the presentation by Bob Raeman of the Planning Board and Amanda Postma of Renovus Solar located in Trumansburg, New York. The data and presentation was an accumulation of electric usage data from the Town Hall, Town Barns, Bristol Volunteer Fire Department, and the Bristol Library. It was accumulated and analyzed to show what if any benefits the town could gain by doing a joint Solar project between the 4 entities.

The second part of the meeting involved a public hearing on the Town's proposed ***Keeping of Animals other than dogs***. There were some who were in favor of such a law and others who thought it was not appropriate and would be very difficult to enforce. The result of the meeting was the Town Board asked to have an ad hoc group discuss the law and follow up with a meeting with the Town Board on their recommendations if the Town should proceed with such a law.
