TOWN OF BRISTOL PUBLIC HEARING LOCAL LAW #1-TAX CAP REGULAR MEETING August 14, 2017 7:00 PM

The Supervisor called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 PM. The Town Clerk read the public notice. There was no one who wished to address the Local Law. The Supervisor explained the process to those present. The Public Hearing was closed at 7:10 PM.

The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:10 PM. Privilege of the floor was given to Elizabeth Smith who reminded the Board that the Bristol Library will be holding their walk in the Park on August 26th. They hope to have a small famer's market and a white elephant sale setup there Marty Snyder the weatherman from Channel 13 will be doing a presentation at the Library on August 15th at 10:00 AM.

Privilege of the floor was given to Liz Brown from Fisher Hill Road. She express concern about water spilling on her property from the neighbor placing drainage tile on their property. If the problem of redirecting the water cannot be settled, she was told to contact Ontario County Soil and Water.

Privilege of the floor was given to Robert Stryker of Fisher Hill Road. He passed out a map of where he was moving his driveway which would give him access to his proposed barn. The Board and Highway Supt. Were in agreement to the new location. He also presented statistics he compiled on site distances for other resident's driveways on Fisher Hill Road.

Privilege of the floor was given to Regina Sousa from Ontario County Planning, who gave a presentation on Consolidated solid waste. She explained that the three owns, Bristol, East and West Bloomfield have received municipal funding, which they can pool together to create new projects to help elevate the solid waste concern. The County landfill is expected to be closed in 2028. A final contract will be drawn up when all towns give approval.

A motion was made by David Parsons, seconded by Jeff Bliss, and carried to approve the minutes of the July 10, 2017 meeting.

Sandy Riker, Secretary of the Planning and Zoning Boards, submitted their monthly report. They reviewed a lot line adjustment for Day Road. They reviewed a site plan in the steep slope area. The Planning Board and ZBA have been reviewing "home business and home occupation definitions.

Sandy Riker, Secretary for the Code Enforcement Officer, submitted the monthly report. Seven permits were issued. Thirteen onsite inspections were done. He participated in a webinar on "Technology for Code Enforcement."

Ron Wilson, Hwy Supt. submitted his monthly report. They have been cleaning ditches and changing culverts. Vincent Hill Road is almost ready o have the gutters installed. The salt will be order by the end of the month to full fill our contract. The cost to install the covers on the salt buildings by the company was about \$1,000.00 David Parsons was opposed to the cost and asked that it be held over until next month.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Jeff Bliss to authorize the Supervisor to sign the Snow & Ice contract with NYS Dot and sign the mowing contact with Ontario County. The Agreement to Spend Town Highway Funds was approved by a motion of Jeff Bliss and a second from Tom Stevens and carried.

Committee Reports- Tom Stevens reported The grant for the park look pretty good. He is not sure if the amount can be increased or not. He will do some further checking on this

. The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by David Parsons and carried to accept all departmental reports.

The Supervisor advised the Board tht he has appointed David Parsons as Deputy Supervisor..
