REGULAR MEETING  
JUNE 13, 2016

The Supervisor called the first Public Hearing to order at 7:00 PM. on Local Law #1-Tax Cap Override. There was no one present who wished to address the Board. The first Public Hearing was closed. The Supervisor called the second Public Hearing to order on Local Law #2- Amending Local Law #3-2011-regarding the legal description of the location and boundaries of the Light Industrial Use District. There was no one present who wished to address the Board. The Supervisor closed the second Public Hearing. The Supervisor called the third Public Hearing to order on Local Law #3- To Amend the Official Zoning Map of the Town of Bristol to depict the Steep Slopes Overlay District. There was no one present who wished to address the Board. The Supervisor closed the Public Hearing.

The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM. There was no one present who wished privilege of the floor. Privilege of the floor was closed. Sandy Riker, Secretary of the Planning Board, submitted their monthly report. They had an informational meeting with Donald Dean in regards to a lot line adjustment for his property on County Road 33. They advised the applicant who is planning a house on Evert Road that they will need a SWPPP along with a steep slopes application before their next meeting. She has received information on solar energy and has shared it with the Planning and Town Boards. At the present time the town has no regulations for minor and major projects. It maybe something the Board should begin reviewing.

Sandy Riker, Secretary for the Code Enforcement Officer, submitted the monthly report. Eight permits were issued. He has begun his annual fire inspections for public assembly. He attended the NYMIR Playground Equipment Inspections & Maintenance Training and the Canandaigua Lake Watershed meeting.

Ron Wilson, Hwy Supt. was attending the annual Highway Supt. Conference and submitted a written monthly report. Results from items taken to the Palmyra Auction were- D-6 Dozer \$17,000, old power washer \$250, 1960 Oshkosh \$650, 8 Haldex half brake cans \$200. They are replacing culvert pipes on Whitetail subdivision which have rotten thru. Oiling and stoning is done for the year.

Committee Reports- Tom Stevens reported the Fun Day and the parade was a huge success. Some people requested to participate in another parade next year.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report.

The Comprehensive Plan Committee is in the process of reviewing our current plan. The minutes will be posted on the web site. The next meeting will be June 15<sup>th</sup>.

A quote was received from NYMIR regarding Cyber Liability insurance. A motion was made by Jeff Bliss and seconded by David Parsons and carried to authorize the Supervisor to contact our agent and purchase the policy for \$404.80 for the term of June 6, 2016-Feb 1, 2017.

A motion was made by Supervisor Green and seconded by Jeff Bliss to adjourn the regular session at 8:20 PM and enter into Executive Session per Section 105of the POL –Sub f.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Al Favro to adjourn the Executive Session at 8:45 and reconvene into the regular meeting.

A motion was made by Supervisor Green and seconded by Al Favro and carried to hold a special session of the Town Board on June 27<sup>th</sup> at 6:30 PM.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by al Favro and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:50 PM.
