PUBLIC HEARING-LOCAL PARK LAW
REGULAR MEETING
JUNE 9, 2014

The Supervisor called the Public Hearing on Local Law 2-Town of Bristol Park Use Law to order at 7:00 PM. There was no one present who wished to address the proposed Local Law. The Public Hearing was closed at 7:08.

The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:08 PM. Privilege of the floor was given to Tom Stevens, who introduced Jacob Foote. He is an Eagle Scout who would like to have permission to erect a Veterans Memorial in the Town Park for his project. He presented a drawing of the proposed memorial. The Board gave their approval to allow him to pursue with his project. Privilege of the floor was given to Lawrence Karz. He stated he is opposed to all fracking. He stated the entire Finger Lakes region is unique and why should we take a chance of allowing fracking. He does have a concern of allowing it on small parcels, where it could do harm to the neighbors property. Nick Cohen expressed his concern that 80,000 gallon limit is too much. Judy Salsburg Taylor thanked the Planning Board for all their work. Her concern was the number of times HVHF was used in the draft local law and does it weaken the proposed law. She also she was still on call if needed. Lynn Cronise asked how many farms are in Bristol and would this effect the right to farm law.

Privilege of the floor was closed at 7:40 PM.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept the May minutes as presented.

Sandy Riker, Chairman of the Planning Board, submitted their monthly report. They reviewed comments from the Town Board regarding proposed changes to zoning regulations. They continue to work on definitions for zoning changes. Reviewed notes from the workshop and revisions made by Tim Jensen on the proposed HVHF local law.

Sandy Riker, Secretary for the Code Enforcement Officer, submitted the monthly report. Nine permits were issued. The flood hazard mitigation data collection is still being submitted. Towns countywide are participating in this issue. Phil began doing his annual fire inspections.

Ron Wilson, Hwy Supt. submitted his monthly report. The 2012 Ford was taken to the Palmyra auction and was sold for \$23,500. Warner's will begin doing the grinding of the brush at the transfer station soon. There was major damage caused by the May 16th storm. There was major flooding across many roads. Tilton Road was closed due to the culvert collapsing. We are trying to get FEMA money to cover some of the cost for repairs. The 2015 Mack truck has been delivered. They have oiled and stoned Oakmount, Baptist Hill, Briggs, Buckelew, Logan and Fawn Ridge roads.

Committee Reports- Tom Stevens reported the Fun Day was a huge success. They estimated that there were about 500 people in attendance. There were about 50 antique vehicles on display. The chicken BBQ was sold out as well as hamburgers and hot dogs and pies. The Band Red Sky went over very well.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept all departmental reports.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Bruce Harter to adopt Local Law 2 Town of Bristol Park Use Local Law. Roll call vote was taken. Supervisor Green-Yes, Al Favro-Yes, Bruce Harter-Yes, David Parsons-Yes and Tom Stevens-Yes.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to appoint Laurie White as custodial worker effective 6/9/14 at the rate of \$11.00/hr.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by David Parsons to hold a Public Hearing on July 14 at 7:00 PM for Local Law 3-To Permit Best Value Contracts.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to authorize the Supervisor Green to sign the Richmond Recreation Agreement with the Town of Richmond.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:40 PM.
