

TOWN OF BRISTOL
PUBLIC HEARINGS –BUDGET/FIRE CONTRACT/WATER DISTRICT
REGULAR MEETING
OCTOBER 14, 2014

PRESENT: Robert A. Green, Jr, Bruce Harter, David Parsons, Alden Favro, Thomas Stevens, Ron Wilson, Sharon Miller, William Kenyon, Atty

The Supervisor called the Public Hearing to order at 7:00 PM. He gave a brief review of the proposed Budget for 2015. There was no one present who wished to address the Board on the proposed Budget. The Supervisor closed the Public Hearing at 7:05 PM.

The Supervisor called the meeting to order at 7:05 PM. Privilege of the floor was given to Laurence Karz., Nick Cohen, Wayne Houseman, Catherine Cohen, Lynn Cronise Carol Hackenhauer, Larry Scott, Cora Jokinen, John Campbell, Jennifer Ford, Scott Preston, Natalie Luntz, Judy Saulsberg Taylor, Martha Herbig and Margaret Deats. They all voiced their concerns, pro and con toward the proposed local law as it pertains to large scale Natural Gas and/or Petroleum Extraction Activities and Material Disposal Sites.

Privilege of the floor was closed at 7:50 PM.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to accept the September minutes as presented.

A motion was made by Tom Stevens and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to pay the following bills:

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to accept the Supervisor's financial report for the month of September.

Bulk water sales for the month of September were \$491.00.

Sandra Riker, Temporary Chairman of the Planning Board, submitted their monthly report. They approved a parcel combination for Ron Lawson on Rt 64. They accept the lot line adjustment requested for property being sold by Crofts Gorsline. They reviewed the Steep Slopes application. They would like to recommend that the Planning Board should look at all development including single family residence in the Town.

Sandy Riker, Secretary for the Code Enforcement Officer, submitted their monthly report. Five permits were issued. Phil attended the Watershed Land Use Work Group session at the Ontario County Training Center.

Ron Wilson, Hwy Supt. submitted his monthly report. The salt barn is full. He informed the men that there is a need to cut back on how much salt is being used this winter season. The creek project on Lower Egypt Road is completed. He is working with FEMA on the necessary paperwork needed to be filed for reimbursement. A 72" culvert pipe was installed on Kear Road. Discussion was held on the Snow and Ice contract with the County. At this time the Board was not in favor of signing the contract for only a 1% increase, when the price of salt increase by 34%. They felt the price should be re-negotiated. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to authorize the Supervisor to sign the Snow & Ice contract with NYS DOT. The 2000 Mack was sent to the Monroe County Municipal Auction and was sold for \$21,000.00.

Committee Reports- Tom Stevens reported that there will be a dedication of the new Veterans Memorial area in the Park on November 11th. More details will be posted on the web site. The roofs on the two park pavilions have been re-roofed.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report.

A motion was made by Bruce Harter and seconded by David Parsons and carried to accept all departmental reports.

Discussion was held on the proposed Local Law regarding fracking. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Tom Stevens to table the decision at this time and revisit the exemption section of the local law, upon the release of the Governor's Health Impact Study. Roll Call vote was taken. Councilman Favro-Yes, Councilman Parsons-Yes, Supervisor Green-Yes, Councilman Harter-Yes and Councilman Stevens-Yes. A motion was made by Supervisor Green and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to hold a Public Hearing on November 10, 2014 at 7:00 PM. to extend an existing moratorium within the Town of Bristol of Natural Gas & Petroleum Exploration and Extraction Activities, Underground Storage of Natural Gas, and Disposal of Natural Gas or Petroleum Extraction, Exploration and Production Wastes.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by Bruce Harter and carried to re-appoint Sandra Riker as the town's representative to the Ontario County Planning Board. Her term will begin January 1, 2015 and expire on December 31, 2019.

A motion was made by Supervisor Green and seconded by David Parsons and carried to appoint Donna Beretta of 6316 Dugway Road, Canandaigua, NY to the Zoning Board of Appeals. She will fill the term of Patti Giordano to expire 12/31/17.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Supervisor Green and carried to adopt the 2015 Preliminary Budget as the final Budget for 2015.

Discussion was held on the use of bounce houses in the Park. The Board decided to table their decision on the use until we heard further from our insurance agent.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by David Parsons and carried to have residents who use the transfer station facility for uses other than refuse disposal, sign an annual non-liability form.

A motion was made by Al Favro and seconded by Tom Stevens and carried to adjourn the meeting at 8:42 PM.
