SPECIAL MEETING  
PUBLIC HEARINGS- 2019 TOWN BUDGET & FIRE CONTRACT  
OCTOBER 29, 2018

PRESENT: Robert A. Green, Jr, David Parsons, Lauren Bolonda, Fred Stressing, Jeff Bliss-absent Ron Wilson, Sharon Miller.

The Supervisor called the Public Hearing on the proposed 2019 contract with the Bristol Volunteer Fire Department at 7:00 PM. Privilege of the floor was given to Mark Francese, President of the fire department. He thanked the Board for their support of past years. He explained that the department may lose the financial support from the Town of Canandaigua in 2020. The state has instituted a mandated NYS Volunteer Firefighter Cancer Benefit Program which will cause financial burden to the department. There is not much information available as to the cost as of yet. The amount that the Town has proposed in the 2019 Town Budget for the contract with the fire department is \$200,000.00.

The Supervisor explained that the 2019 Town Budget was within the 2% Tax Cap. The Public Hearings were closed at 7:120 PM.

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Lauren Bolonda and carried to adopt the 2019 Preliminary Budget as the Town Budget for 2019.

A motion was made by Fred Stresing and seconded by David Parsons and carried to adopt the Policy Against Discrimination and Harassment. (a copy is attached to these minutes).

A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Lauren Bolonda and carried to authorize the Supervisor to sign a contract with the Ontario County Sheriff's Department to provide a deputy to be in attendance in our Court on DA nights.

A motion was made by Fred Stresing and seconded by Lauren Bolonda and carried to authorize the payment to Hanson Aggregates to allow the Highway Superintendent to submit the necessary forms to receive reimbursement for the CHIPS Program.

A motion was made by Lauren Bolonda and seconded by David Parsons and carried to adopt the Energy Benchmarking Requirements for Certain Municipal Buildings. This will allow us to receive a grant for future improvements.

A motion was mad4 by Lauren Bolonda and seconded by David Parsons and carried to adjourn the regular session and go into Executive Session for personnel issues at 7:30 PM. A motion was made by David Parsons and seconded by Lauren Bolonda and carried to adjourn the Executive Session at 7:40 PM and go back into the regular meeting.

A motion was made by Fred Stresing and seconded by Lauren Bolonda and carried to adjourn the meeting at 7:40 PM.
