Sandy Riker, Secretary for the Code Enforcement Officer, submitted a written monthly report. Five permits were issued. The property at Fungus Creek has been mowed. He is still waiting to hear from the realtor on the inspection findings. .

Ron Wilson, Hwy Supt. submitted his monthly report. He is working with the County Engineer on finalizing the plans for completing Vincent Hill Road. A larger cross culvert pipe was installed by Langer's on Baptist Hill Road. Wedging will be done on Baptist Hill, Bailey and Elm Tree Roads. Tom suggested that he take a look at Egypt Road for wedging also. He tried a product called Dust Oil on some dirt roads. It is the same price or less than calcium chloride and seemed to work well. Harold Parrish was hired as a temporary part time mower to help catch up on roadside mowing. He is working with the State revising the road inventory mileage. He will keep the Board informed on the progress.

The Town Clerk submitted her monthly report.

Discussion was held on the changes to the Park Local Law. It was decided to continue the discussion at the September meeting.
